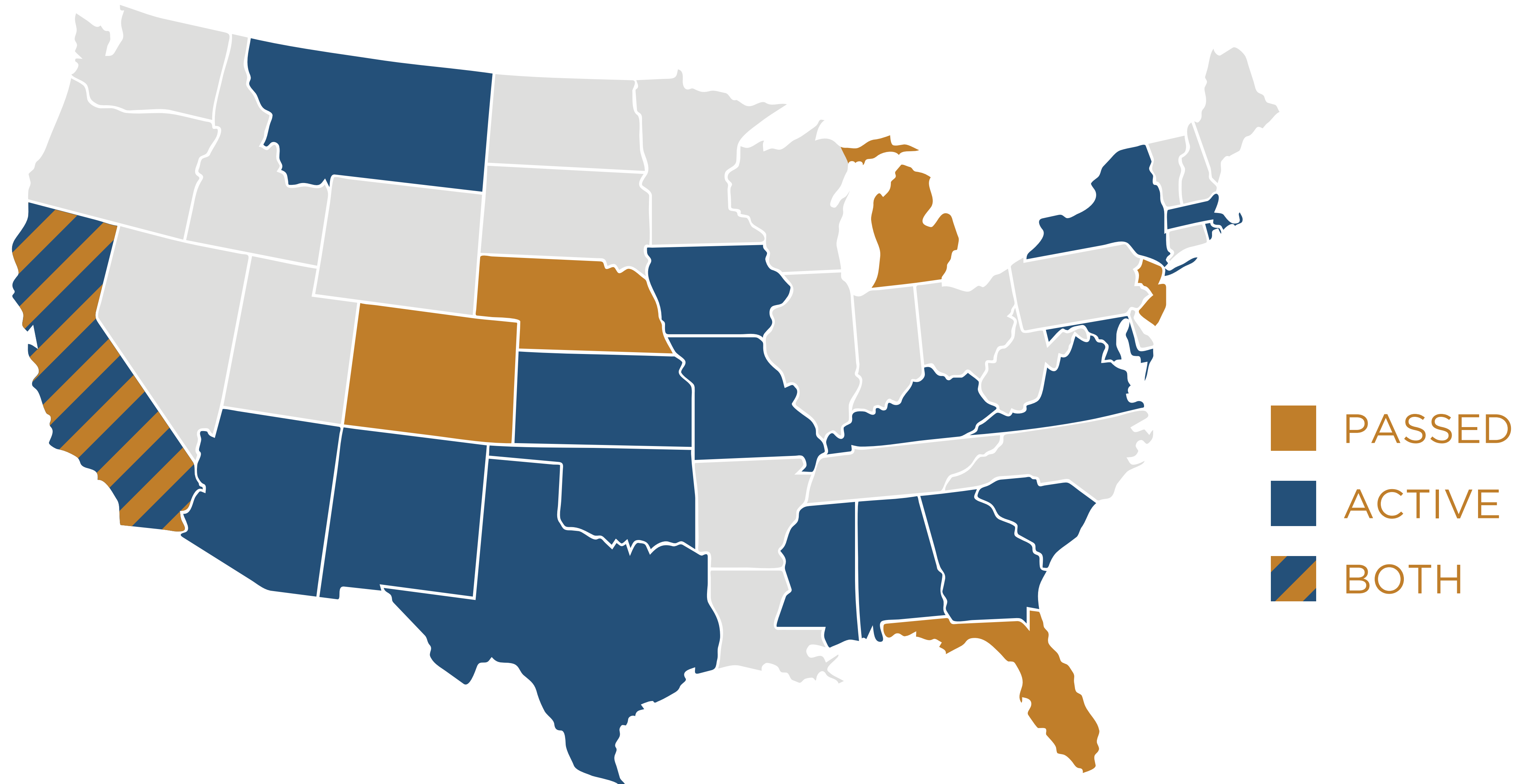

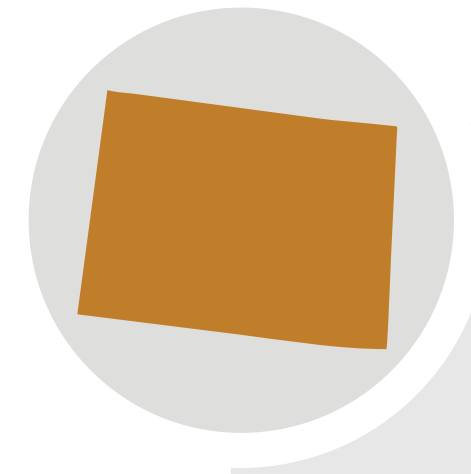
SB 206:

Fair Pay to Play Act

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL, and prohibits the school from paying prospective students in relation to their NIL.

Compensation & Representation Of Student Athletes

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL, and prohibits the school from paying prospective or current students to participate in intercollegiate sports.

FLORIDA

SB 646:

The Intercollegiate Athlete Compensation and Rights Bill

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL, and prohibits the school from paying prospective or current students to participate in intercollegiate sports.

MICHIGAN

HB 5217:

AN ACT to prohibit postsecondary educational institutions in this state and certain athletic organizations from preventing a college athlete from receiving compensation for the use of his or her name, image, or likeness rights.

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL, and prohibits the school from paying prospective students in relation to their NIL.

NEBRASKA

LB 962:

The Nebraska Fair Pay to Play Act

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL.

Each postsecondary institution in the state has until July 1, 2023 to choose when the law will apply to it and its student athletes.

NEW JERSEY

S 917:

New Jersey Fair Play Act

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL.

Law takes effect immediately and shall first be applicable in the fifth academic year following the date of enactment.

ALABAMA

HB 150:

Fair Pay to Play Bill

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL; if a student opts not to seek compensation for their NIL, the college would be required to deposit up to \$10,000 annually into an annuity account for that student.

SB 26:

Fair Pay to Play Bill

Adds “athletic reputation” as part of “name, image, likeness” into existing law.

College Athlete Race and Gender Equity Act

Requires revenue sharing between colleges and student-athletes; prohibits new athletic facilities from being built for 10 years, and suspends athletic directors for 3 years if their departments fall out of compliance with Title IX.

HB 8:

Requires colleges to deposit a portion of all revenue derived from its athletic programs into an escrow account to be distributed among eligible student-athletes on a pro rata basis upon graduation.

SB 249:

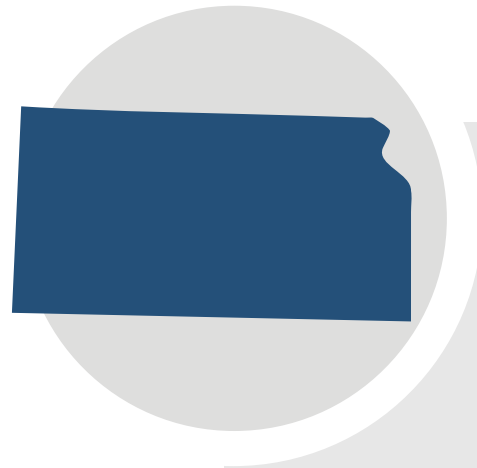
An Act relating to intercollegiate athletics

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL, and prohibits the school from paying students to participate in intercollegiate sports.

KANSAS

HB 2264:

Permitting student athletes at postsecondary educational institutions to receive compensation for the use of their name, image, likeness rights or athletic reputation.

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL, and prohibits the school from paying prospective or current students to participate in intercollegiate sports.

MASSACHUSETTS

HB 337:

An Act relative to intercollegiate compensation and rights

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL and mandates any student can wear the footwear of their choice during competition.

MASSACHUSETTS

HB 4047:

Massachusetts collegiate athletic participation compensation act

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL; establishes an injured-athlete fund to compensate an athlete for a career-ending injury, requires each institution to take 15% of the revenue earned from ticket sales to all athletic events and divide and pay such amount to all student-athletes.

MARYLAND

HB 125:

Jordan McNair Safe and Fair Play Act

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL; requires 5 year scholarships for student-athletes, and mandates the school must pay the health insurance premiums for participating student athletes who qualify for the federal Pell Grant.

MISSISSIPPI

HB 1030:

Mississippi Intercollegiate Athletics Compensation Rights Act

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL, prohibits the school from paying the athlete to participate in intercollegiate sports, and prohibits male athletes from being compensated for their NIL as a female or for any athletic team designated for females.

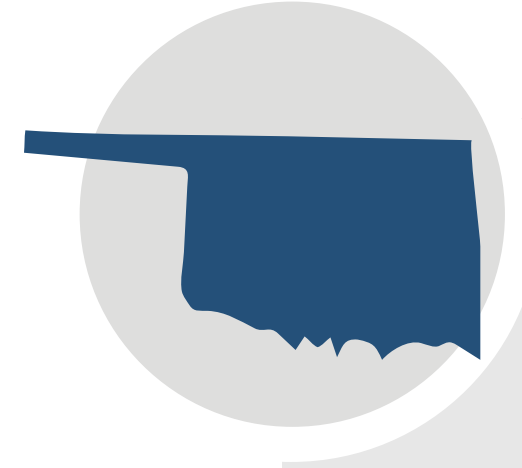
SB3513:

Allowing compensation for use of a student athlete's name, image or likeness

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL and prohibits a school from providing a prospective student athlete with compensation in relation to their NIL.

S. CAROLINA

SB 256:

Student Athlete Name, Image, or Likeness Compensation

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL, and prohibits the school from paying a student-athlete to participate in intercollegiate sports; allows stipends to be awarded to student-athletes, and creates a student-athlete trust fund where for each year that a student-athlete maintains good academic standing, five thousand dollars will be deposited into the fund on their behalf.

VIRGINIA

SB 464:

Intercollegiate athletics; student-athletes; compensation, representation, and injury

Allows student-athletes to be compensated for their NIL, prohibits a school from providing a prospective student athlete with compensation in relation to their NIL, and requires schools to establish an injury fund and wage fund to pay student-athletes directly at the end of each year.
